COVID-19 Virus Update

The number of coronavirus cases in McMinn County has jumped sharply, due in part to nursing home cases. The latest numbers show McMinn County with a total of 14 cases and 4 recoveries. Monroe County has 13 cases total, with 9 recoveries and 1 death. Statewide the total cases stands at 9,667 with 181 deaths.

RESTAURANTS CAN OPEN TODAY

Restaurants in Tennessee can re-open their inside dinning areas today, but not all are planning to open quite yet. They will be restricted to no more than 50% of seating capacity. Tables must be spaced six feet apart. No self-service buffets will be allowed. Employees must wear masks and gloves. Restaurants must use either disposable menus or sanitize menus between each use.

◆ ATHENS POLICE NAB BURGLARY SUSPECTS

Two Athens men, Ryan Striker and Zachery Roderick, have been charged in connection with an attempted burglary at Dunham's Sporting Goods on Decatur Pike early last Friday. Police responded to a burglar alarm at Dunham's. When they arrived, they encountered a car occupied by Striker and Roderick. There were signs of possible forced entry on the rear doors of the store. Police found a crowbar, various tools, and suspected meth in the car. The occupants confessed they had attempted to break into Dunham's. Officers believe the various power tools found in the vehicle may have been stolen.
