COVID-19 Virus Update

The number of cases of the coronavirus in Tennessee is 20,607 with 13,873 recoveries. There have been 338 deaths from the virus in Tennessee. As of Monday afternoon, the total number of coronavirus cases in McMinn County is 135 with 93 recoveries and 14 deaths. Monroe County has 56 cases with 2 deaths. Meigs County has 25 cases. Bradley County has 98 cases with 1 death and Polk County has 14 cases.
