#### ETOWAH MAN KILLED IN CAR-TRAIN CRASH

The Tennessee Highway Patrol has identified the driver of a car who was killed when he drove into the path of a train on Wednesday morning. He was Armando A. Fernandez-Pascual, 81, of Etowah. The THP says the train was traveling east on Norfolk Southern tracks when the car driven by Fernandez-Pascual crossed into the train's path on County Road 717 just off U.S. 11. The train struck the left center of the car, pushing it about 2,600 feet. Fernandez was killed and pronounced dead at the scene.


#### **CORONAVIRUS UPDATE AS OF JUNE 11**

The number of confirmed cases of the coronavirus in Tennessee has increased by 471, now standing at 28,340. There have been 441 deaths, an increase of 5. McMinn County's total number of cases has increased to 161, up 2 from Wednesday. Of those, 122 patients have recovered and 14 have died. The totals in Monroe County are 75 cases with 63 recoveries and 4 deaths. Bradley County's total at this point is 241, with 165 recoveries and 2 deaths. In Polk County there have been 24 cases of the virus and 20 patients have recovered. Meigs County reports 28 cases with 27 recoveries. Rhea County's total is 220, with 206 recovered.
