COVID-19 Virus Update

As of Sunday, Tennessee has had 35,102 cases of COVID-19 (up 656), with 23,067 recoveries and 526 deaths. McMinn County reports 173 cases with 138 recoveries and 15 deaths. Rhea County shows 256 cases, with 227 recoveries. Meigs County reports 31 cases, with 25 recoveries. Monroe County's total is 108 with 82 recoveries and 4 deaths. Bradley County has 338 cases, 244 recoveries, and 3 deaths. Polk County reports 32 cases with 26 recoveries.


