Blood Assurance continues to collect plasma donations from recovered COVID-19 donors to be used as an investigational treatment for hospitalized COVID-19 patients. As the demand for this treatment increases in hospitals across Southeast Tennessee, Blood Assurance is in desperate need for more plasma donors. To donate convalescent plasma for patients in need, donors must have been officially diagnosed with COVID-19, must pass all standard requirements to give plasma, and must be symptom free for 14 days. Central-MCHS Graduations Set

Plans have been announced for the Central and McMinn County High School graduation exercises. Central's "Drop By" graduation will be held on Friday, July 24th. Each graduate may bring up to 6 guests. The graduate needs to be wearing his/her cap & gown. Each graduate will be given a number to display on the vehicle dash. The graduates and guests will enter through the main entrance when their number is called/displayed. When notified, the graduate & party will enter the auditorium & proceed to the front. When his/her name is called, the graduate will walk across the stage and pick up the diploma from the table. The graduate & party will then exit the auditorium, go straight to their vehicle, and leave the campus.

McMinn County High School's "Walk Through" graduation will be Saturday, July 25th, from 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Graduates will be separated by alphabetical order into 6 groups, starting with Group 1 (Achilles thru Cates) from 9 to 10:30 a.m. Group 1 will enter the parking lot through Main Stadium Gate on Rocky Mount Rd. Group 2 will enter the parking lot through the Tennis Courts Gate on Congress Parkway. During the remainder of the day, the groups will alternate between the two parking lot entrances. Face masks are encouraged and social distancing will be observed. Graduates will enter the gym lobby and walk down the PE Hall where they will receive their diplomas. They will then enter the gymnasium and walk across the stage, and then exit the building.

COVID 19 VIRUS UPDATE

The number of COVID-19 cases in Tennessee keeps going up. Monday's total stands at 65,274, an increase of 3,314 since Sunday, with 36,996 recovered and 749 deaths. McMinn County's total is 293 with 188 recovered. Rhea County has had 350 cases. with 255 recovered. Meigs County has 40 cases with 28 recovered. Polk County's total is 57 cases with 39 recovered. Monroe County has 156 cases, 108 recoveries. Bradley County has had 1,010 cases, 541 recoveries. There were no changes in the death total for the above mentioned counties from previous update.

Athens Native Heads Georgia Educators

Lisa Morgan, a native of Athens, has been elected President of the Georgia Association of Educators. Lisa was born and raised in Athens and graduated from McMinn County High School in 1987. She taught Kindergarten in DeKalb County Schools in Georgia, prior to her election. She says her short-term goal as President of GAE is to help members navigate the unpredictable circumstances surrounding the reopening of Georgia's public



schools which have been closed due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Schultz is a 30-year veteran of the Athens Fire Department. He joined the fire department in 1990 as a firefighter.
