TODAY IN HISTORY - JULY 24th

1704 - The British captured Gibraltar, allowing them to freely travel in and out of the Mediterranean Sea.

1783 - The Venezuelan general Simón Bolivar was born. He was known as "The Liberator" in much of South America, and he helped win independence for Bolivia, Colombia, Ecuador, Peru, and Venezuela.

1866 - Tennessee became the first state to be readmitted to the Union after the Civil War.

1897 - Aviator Amelia Earhart was born. In 1935, she made the first solo flight from Honolulu to the U.S. mainland. In 1937, she disappeared over the Pacific ocean while trying to make a round-the-world flight.

1969 - Apollo 11, the first manned mission to the moon, splashed down safely in the Pacific.

1979 - A Miami jury convicted Ted Bundy of first-degree murder in the slayings of two Florida State University sorority sisters.

1974 - The Supreme Court ruled unanimously that President Nixon had to turn over subpoenaed White House tape recordings to the Watergate special prosecutor.
