COVID-19 Developments

- ✓ A leader in the fight against COVID-19 in Nashville shares his concerns about gatherings that could become "superspreader" events if friends and family let their guards down. Dr. Alex Jahangir, chair of the Metro Nashville Coronavirus Task Force, says you may think it's safe because you know everyone and you're sure they don't have COVID. He says don't get lulled into that kind of thinking because those types of gatherings can become events where multiple people or even an entire party become infected. He says you should keep gatherings below 25 people.
- ✓ Radio talk show host and former presidential candidate Herman Cain has died of the coronavirus at the age of 74. Cain had been at a higher risk due to his age and a previous battle with cancer. Two weeks before falling ill, he attended a Trump rally in Tulsa, Oklahoma, without wearing a mask.
- ✓ The Tennessee Highway Patrol reports it spent nearly \$1 million for troopers to guard the Capitol building during last month's protests in Nashville.
- ✓ The number of virus cases in Tennessee now stands at 102,871, up 2,049 from Wednesday. Deaths are 1,033, up 13.

Polk County: 134 cases, 70 active, and 1 death.


