WE WILL NEVER FORGET

Today marks the 19th anniversary of the terrorist attacks on the World Trade Center Twin Towers in New York City. Terrorists from the Islamic group al-Qaeda hijacked passenger jets and flew them into the towers and into the Pentagon. A fourth hijacked plane crashed in Pennsylvania after several passengers stormed the cockpit. The death toll was 2,977.

THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. equities ended lower. Energy, technology and utilities sectors were hit the hardest. The materials sector held up better. U.S. initial claims, a measure to gauge layoffs, came in higher than expected. Citigroup announced Jane Fraser, Citigroup's president, will replace Michael Corbat as chief executive. Fraser is the first woman to lead a major Wall Street bank. Treasury prices increased.

The Dow Jones Industrial Average was down 406 points or 1.5% to 27,535. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 60 points or 1.8% to 3,339, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 222 points or 2.0% to 10,920.

TODAY IN HISTORY - September 11th

1789 -Alexander Hamilton was appointed the first U.S. Secretary of the Treasury.

1899 - Singer and former Louisiana Governor Jimmie Davis was born. He recorded "You Are My Sunshine."

1936 - President Franklin Roosevelt dedicated Boulder Dam (now Hoover Dam) by pressing a button in Washington to start the dam's hydroelectric generator.

2008 - U.Ś. President George W. Bush attended the dedication of a memorial at the Pentagon in honor of the 9/11 attacks in 2001. In New York City, Mayor Michael Bloomberg led a ceremony attended by presidential candidates Barack Obama and John McCain.
