# How to Thaw a Turkey

Time is of the essence. Butterball says the best way to thaw a frozen turkey is in the refrigerator...at least 1 day for every 4 pounds of turkey. Thaw the turkey breast side up in the unopened wrapper in the fridge. Cold water is faster. Thaw the unopened turkey in a pan with enough cold water to cover the turkey completely. Change the water every 30 minutes. Estimate a minimum thawing time of 20 minutes per pound of turkey.
