Global stocks are also taking a breather after a record-setting month, with the world index heading for its best monthly performance since 1988. Oil is higher, up more than 7% for this week and back to its highest level since early March. Ten-year Treasury yields are little changed. Domestic markets were closed on Thursday for Thanksgiving but will open for a half day on Friday.
