## More COVID News

- The entire Meigs County football team is now in quarantine, following their state championship loss last Saturday in Cookeville. Meigs County Director of Schools Clint Baker says the quarantine is a "precautionary situation," and that other schools that were at the championship game have been contacted regarding a potential exposure to COVID-19. Baker did now say whether the contact happened during the weekend or during the championship game. He says the school district was made aware of the possible exposure on Monday, and players entered quarantine on Monday as well.
- A new study by Vanderbilt University highlights how some Tennessee parents are approaching the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. The study asked 1,066 parents their thoughts on COVID-19 policies. It found that only 57% of the parents reported wearing a mask or face covering every time they were in stores, businesses, or outside the home in the past month. The poll also found that only about half of the parents surveyed reported they are likely to get the COVID-19 vaccine for their child.
