

of the Pfizer ment COVID-19 vaccine. The state got an early shipment of 975 doses to hold as an emergency backup supply should any receiving hospital's supply be damaged.



Tennessee anticipates receiving 56,550 doses on Thursday to be sent to 74 hospitals. A second shipment of 56,500 doses is expected about three weeks later. The vaccine will go to front-line health care workers and long-term care facility residents and staff.
