TODAY IN HISTORY - DECEMBER 23rd

1783 - George Washington returned to Mount Vernon, after the disbanding of his army following the Revolutionary War.

- 1787 Captain William Bligh and his crew sailed from Plymouth, England, on their ship the "Bounty." Their plan was to gather information about the south Pacific islands. However, a group led by Fletcher Christian took over the ship and set Captain Bligh and his crew adrift in a small boat.
- 1823 The poem "A Visit from St. Nicholas" by Clement C. Moore was published in the Troy, New York, "Sentinel." The poem later came to be known better by the title: "Twas the Night Before Christmas."
- **1913 -** The Federal Reserve Act was signed into law by President Woodrow Wilson. It established 12 Federal Reserve Banks.
- **1928 -** The National Broadcasting Company established its first permanent coast-to-coast radio network.
- **1948 -** Former Japanese premier Tojo was hanged in Tokyo by the Allied War Crimes Commission.
