Breaking Down the Numbers

Each day we report the latest COVID-19 cases and the death toll for McMinn County and surrounding counties. In an effort to put things in a little more perspective, here is what the latest figures tell us based on the population of each county:

McMinn County - 7.9% of the residents of McMinn County have tested positive for COVID-19. Of those, .114% have died.

Meigs County - 7.6% of the residents of Meigs County have tested positive for COVID. Of those, .123% have died.

Monroe County - 8% of the residents of Monroe County have tested positive for COVID. Of those, .115% have died.

Bradley County - 7.9% of the residents of Bradley County have tested positive for COVID. Of those, .114% have died.

Polk County - 6.65% of the residents of Polk County have tested positive for COVID. Of those, .095% have died.

Rhea County - 9.2% of the residents of Rhea County have tested positive for COVID. Of those, .138% have died.

The numbers show Rhea County with the highest percentage of deaths and Polk County with the lowest.
