✓ Tennessee Wesleyan University plans to continue in-person instruction this coming fall semester. TWU has remained inperson throughout the 2020-21 school year, with a variety of COVID-19 restrictions in place. Dr. Grant Wilhite, VP for Academic Affairs, says they will continue to practice social distancing and require masks in the classrooms. The school stressed cautious optimism about the opening of campus events and in-seat instruction, dependent on the continued improving of regional COVID-19 cases. As before, a variety of courses will still operate online only, regardless of any change in policy due to COVID-19. A Home for Kids

It's not uncommon for the courts to remove a child from their home for their safety. When that happens, the child is taken to a Department of Children Services office to wait for hours, sometimes for several days, for foster placement. A non-profit organization known as Isaiah 117 is trying to change that by building a halfway house for children in McMinn and Monroe counties. The

organization is currently looking for an acre of land in the Englewood area. When the Isaiah House is finished, children will be able to go into a fully furnished and stocked home instead of sitting in an office. Project Coordinator Jennifer Collins of Tellico says their hope is for there to be no child sitting in a conference room or cubical



during what is already a difficult day. Volunteers will take care of the child and provide them with everything they need, including clothing and toys.
