- ✓ The Tennessee Department of Health has issued a statement on the FDA and CDC recommendations to pause administration of the Johnson & Johnson one-dose vaccine. The Tennessee Department of Health says they have plenty of Pfizer and Moderna vaccine on hand and they do not anticipate the pause on the J & J vaccine will impact Tennessee's efforts to vaccinate as many Tennesseans as possible.
- ✓ The CDC is issuing a daily report on COVID-19 vaccinations in McMinn and other counties. The latest report shows a total of 7,055 people have been vaccinated. That is only 13.1% of the total population. Things are looking better for people 65 and older. The CDC says 4,630 have been vaccinated. That means 43.3% of the older population in McMinn County have gotten their COVID shots. To get yours, call 866-442-5301.

TUESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: U.S. stocks finished mostly higher Tuesday, led by gains in technology shares, even as long-term government bond yields retreated and economic data showed a surge in consumer prices in March. Investors also contended with some negative news on the pandemic front after two U.S. public-health agencies requested a temporary halt in the use of Johnson & Johnson's one-shot COVID vaccine out of "an abundance of caution" due to extremely rare blood-clotting issues in women.

- ✓ The McMinn County Election Commission will meet next Tuesday, April 20th, at 5 p.m. in the conference room of the McMinn County Courthouse to reorganize and approve the budget for 2021-2022.
- ✓ The Tennessee Highway Safety Office will launch a new speeding prevention campaign called "Slow Down Tennessee" on Friday, April 16th. From April 16th through April 30th, the THP along with local law enforcement agencies will increase public education, awareness, and enforcement efforts to reduce speeding related crashes, injuries, and fatalities statewide. There were nearly 23,000 speeding-related crashes in Tennessee from 2017 to 2019. Thirty-six percent of those crashes involved drivers between the ages of 18 and 24.
