✓ Next week is Spring Cleaning Week in Athens and Etowah. Put unwanted furniture, mattresses, and other junk at the curbside and crews will haul it off. Prohibited items in Athens include tanks from vehicles and BBQ grills, tires not separated from rims, appliances with compressor and coolant lines still connected, and shingles. In Etowah, (see ad top, right) they will not accept chemicals, paint, refrigerators, air conditioners, tires, batteries, or mattresses with bed bugs. The McMinn County Landfill is waiving fees for disposal of most items, except tires, next week.

Thursday's Market Report

The major averages finished higher, spurred by encouraging retail sales and employment reports. Equities logged solid gains. Ten year Treasury rates dipped below 1.55% for the first time in a month. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 305.10 to 34,035.99. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 45.76 to 4,170.42, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 180.92 points to 14,038.76.
