
## **Arrests Made in McMinn Murder**

McMinn County Sheriff Joe Guy has announced the arrests of two people in connection with a shooting in the Mt. Verd community Saturday evening that left 54-year-old Mary Denise Dalton dead and 31-year-old Jonathan Burger in the hospital. Sheriff Guy says 24-year-old Esau Kelly of Ooltewah was charged with Second Degree Murder and Attempted Second Degree Murder. Melissa K. Pueirtt, 45, of Etowah, was charged with Accessory After the Fact of Murder in the Second Degree. Guy says the shooting apparently stemmed from a dispute the suspects were having with the victims. • **Robert Keith Myers**, age 62, of Athens died Tuesday at his residence. Arrangements will be announced by Ziegler Funeral Home.


