

Schultz Named Interim Chief

Athens City Manager C. Seth Sumner has named Lieutenant Fred Schultz of the Special Services Division of the Athens Police Department as the Interim Police Chief following the dismissal of Police Chief Cliff Couch last Friday afternoon. Schultz previously worked for the McMinn County Sheriff's Office for 12 years and for the regional Drug Task Force for one year. Couch was dismissed as of 3 p.m. Friday. Sumner says he was given an opportunity to resign, but he did not exercise that opportunity. Couch was named Athens Police Chief on September 25th, 2017, after a nationwide recruitment effort. Couch says he was "shocked" by what was presented to him last Friday and had no plans to resign. Couch says he believes his dismissal was an act of retaliation for something he expressed concern about, 8 months ago. That's when Couch became suspicious of Sumner's role in the disappearance of two "Nest" cameras from the police department's "Sergeant's Closet." Couch also had video showing Sergeant Casey Patterson appearing to return one of the missing cameras to the closet. Couch briefed District Attorney Steve Crump on what was going on and asked for guidance on how to handle the situation. That and other issues led to three members of the Athens City Council asking for a special called meeting to discuss the missing cameras, Chief Couch's allegations of retaliation by Sumner, and several other items including Sumner's possession of a loaded handgun in his carry-on bag at the Knoxville airport.
