Search Is On for Murder Suspect

The search continues in East Tennessee for a Georgia murder suspect. Brandon Neil Wiseman is wanted for murder in Murray County, Georgia that happened Sunday morning. He was spotted in Englewood later in the day. Wiseman had ties to a local busi-

ness in Englewood. When Englewood police investigated the business, they spotted Wiseman with his sister, Jessica Jenkins. The two fled in a brown 1999 Nissan Pathfinder (TN License 1U7-6J6). After a chase, Wiseman let his sister out and then drove across the McMinn-Monroe County line in the Gudger area. Jenkins was taken into custody. Wiseman was spotted later in Madisonville. Law enforcement officers believe that someone took him to Scott County. Wiseman was



last seen wearing blue jeans, a green t-shirt, work boots, and a blue and white baseball hat. He is described as a white male with facial hair, standing 5-10 and weighing 177 pounds. Anyone with any knowledge of his whereabouts should immediately call 911.
