- ✓ The Athens City Council heard reports on police and fire department activity for December at Tuesday night's Council meeting. Interim Police Chief Fred Schultz reported there were 42 thefts, 29 assaults, 8 motor vehicle thefts, 5 burglaries, and one sex offense. Officers issued citations for 134 moving violations. There were 49 traffic accidents with 10 injuries. There are currently four vacancies on the police force.

Fire Chief Brandon Ainsworth reported firefighters responded to 173 calls. Of those, 139 were rescue and EMS calls.

DON'T ASSAULT AN UMPIRE

A Tennessee lawmaker has proposed legislation making contact or injury of a sporting official a crime. The bill comes just after Rep. Jeremy Faison was ejected from a high school basketball game for trying to pull down an official's pants. The bill seeks to make assaulting an official a crime under state law. Assault against an official would be a Class E felony, punishable by up to six years in prison and a \$3,000 fine.
