TODAY IN HISTORY - DEC 01st

1913 - The world's first drive-in gasoline station opened for business in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania.

1917 - Father Edward Flanagan founded Boys Town near Omaha, Nebraska. Boys Town is a private institution for homeless and underprivileged boys of every race and religion. Father Flanagan believed that if boys were given the best possible home, education, and training, they would grow up to be useful, productive adults.

1943 - The so-called "Big Three" meeting ended in Tehran, Iran, with U.S. President Franklin Roosevelt, British Prime Minister Winston Churchill, and Russian Premier Josef Stalin pledging a concerted effort to defeat Nazi Germany.

1945 - Singer and actress Bette Midler was born.

1955 - Rosa Parks defied a segregation ordinance in Montgomery, Alabama, and became a symbol for the Civil Rights movement when she was arrested for refusing to give up her bus seat to a white man.

Grant Recipients

✓ Tennessee Governor Bill Lee and Department of Economic and Community Development Commissioner Stuart McWhorter announced the Tennessee Main Street and Tennessee Downtowns communities that will be recipients of Downtown Improvement Grants. A total of \$1 million in Rural Economic Opportunity funds is being awarded in amounts up to \$100,000 per community to improve structures in Tennessee Downtowns and Main Street communities. Grants were awarded to organizations that illustrated the need for improvements and the ability to execute an effective design plan tor building facades, wayfinding signage, gateways and streetscapes. There were 16 main street and downtown communities that were recipients. The local communities receiving the grants are Etowah, \$50,000; Ducktown, \$70,000; and Cleveland, \$20,000.
