Meadow Branch Landfill Update

Help is apparently on the way to help with the significant odor problem generated by the Meadow Branch Landfill on County Road 166, that has plagued residents in that area for years. McMinn County Mayor John Gentry says that the County has signed a contract with a company known as Envirosuite that uses high technology to map windspeed and direction to determine where an odor is coming from. According to Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation, earlier this year the Meadow Branch Landfill underwent Tier 2 gas testing and analysis. The Tennessee Division of Air Pollution Control calculated the NMOC emissions for the entire site to be well over the limit. According to a company official the landfill has until September 1st, 2023 to submit a gas collection and control design plan and install and operate a regulated gas collection and control system. People living in the area say they are excited that the county and the state are making moves to eliminate the odor problem in their area.
