#### TODAY IN HISTORY - December 19th

**1777** - George Washington & his Continental Army began a winter encampment at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania.

**1871 -** Corrugated paper was patented by Albert L. Jones of New York City. The rippled cardboard stuff still gets used today in boxes and as packing protection.

**1920 -** Country singer Little Jimmy Dickens was born. He was a regular fixture on the Grand Ole Opry Show. He passed away in Nashville on January 2, 2015.

**1957** - Meredith Willson's "The Music Man" opened at the Majestic Theatre in New York City. The Broadway show starred Robert Preston and had a run of 1,375 shows. It also had 76 trombones and 101 cornets in the band.

## Friday's Market Report

Major indexes finished lower. Both the ECB and the Fed reaffirmed that rates will go higher for longer until inflation falls back closer to their targets. While technology stocks led the weekly losses, they held up better on Friday, helped by solid corporate earnings. Oil declined 2.5% to \$74 per barrel. The 10-year Treasury yields were slightly higher at 3.48%. At the closing bell, the Dow Jones Average was down 281.76 to 32,920.46. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was down 43.39 to 3,852.36, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was down 105.11 to 10,705.41.

**ELIJAH McLEAN'S RECOVERY:** Elijah McLean, is a 2 year old little boy who literally drowned in a pond on December 14th, 2021. He went 75 minutes without oxygen to the brain causing **anoxic brain injury**. He is now diagnosed with spastic cerebral palsy. Elijah has great difficulty holding his head up, eating, talking, moving purposefully, and his ability to see or hear has been compromised. Elijah is the 2nd youngest brother of 5.
