WEDNESDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Investor sentiment brightened on Wednesday and equity markets rallied due to upbeat corporate commentary and an improvement in consumer confidence. Government bond yields were little changed. The Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 526.74 to 33,376.48. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 56.82 to 3,878.44, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 162.26 to 10,709.37.
