Fatality on Highway 68

Three vehicles were involved in a motor vehicle accident on Highway 68, Friday, January 27th. A Kenworth Tractor was traveling East on Highway 68. A Ford F350 was traveling West on Highway 68. Another unidentified vehicle pulled out from Cyber Air Road into the tractor's lane of travel. The tractor swerved to avoid striking the unidentified vehicle and struck the Ford. Both vehicles came to final rest outside of the roadway on the Westbound side. The driver of the Ford, forty-five-year-old Tyrone Jenkins, died in the crash according to the Tennessee Highway Patrol. The unidentified vehicle left the scene and no information was provided. The driver of the tractor was uninjured. There are no charges pending at this time per the Tennessee Highway Patrol.

Treasury yields are higher and prices are lower. Asian stocks were higher and European markets edged lower. At the closing bell, The Dow Jones Average was up 28.67 to 33,978.08.
