◆ THURSDAY'S MARKET REPORT: Stocks closed higher on Thursday. Markets continue to find some relief in the fact that the banking crisis has not accelerated after the initial bank failures in mid-March. Longer-term rates were little changed. The 2-year Treasury yields were higher. Real estate, technology and consumer discretionary sectors outperformed. The Nasdaq was higher. The price of oil, WTI crude, was up by more than 1% to 74.37. At the closing bell the Dow Jones Industrial Average was up 141.43 to 32,859.03. The Standard & Poor's 500 Index was up 23.02 to 4,050.83, and the NASDAQ Composite Index was up 87.24 to 12,013.47.
