Arsonist Arrested

A joint investigation by special agents with the Tennessee Bureau of Investigation and the Meigs County Sheriff's Office about a residential fire in that county has resulted in the arrest of a Decatur woman. On October 10th, TBI special agent fire investigators were requested to assist the Meigs County Sheriff's Office in the investigation of a fire at a residence in the 19-thousand block of North Nopone Valley Road. The investigation revealed that the fire had been intentionally set, and that two people had been inside the home at the time. During the course of the investigation, agents and deputies determined that 45 year old Laura Huckabey was the individual responsible for setting the fire. TBI agents obtained arrest warrants for Huckabey for two counts of Aggravated Arson. She was arrested on October 14th by Meigs County deputies and booked into the Meigs County Jail on a \$50,000 bond.

✓The City of Athens is announcing the Patterns of the Past Quilt Trail program to be an added feature to Historic Downtown Athens. A grant has been received from the Tennessee Arts Commission to fund local artists to recreate renderings of quilt patterns to display. The art will be transferred to UV and weather resistant signage similar to those signs you see along the Storybook Trail. This program really is a re-creation of a previous trail "Civil War Heritage Walking Tour" that was created by a local group of residents. Originally there were 15 patterns downtown and each location was strategically mapped out for enjoyment and learning while walking downtown. Additionally, facts about the pattern and location were also a big attraction and eventually became a part of the Appalachian Quilt Trail. Many local businesses beyond the immediate downtown area also started adding quilt squares to their buildings like the McMinn Senior activity Center. Notably, McMinn County was the county in Tennessee to have the most quilt squares displayed! All interested artists are encouraged to attend an informational meeting at the McMinn County Living Heritage Museum on Monday, October 23^r at 5:30 PM to learn how they can participate and the time frame for art submission. There will be 10 patterns that the artists are able to choose from and can submit multiple patterns for this project. Artists will also need to submit a W9 and a brief statement (biographical information and education/training). Continued on page 2
