Howell Proposes More Rafting



Tennessee State Representative Dan Howell, who represents Polk, Meigs and parts of Bradley County in the legislature, is pursing legislative action that, if passed, would extend rafting days on the Ocoee River for this summer. Rep. Howell's proposed bill would enable officials to collaborate with the

deputy commissioner of state parks to negotiate with TVA for additional water release days during the rafting season. The objective of the bill is to attract more tourists and white water rafting enthusiasts to the region. Polk County is one of the premier white water rafting destinations in the U.S. The Ocoee River was notably featured in the 1996 Atlanta Summer Olympics white water events.
