#### Hyde Strikes Out 10 as McMinn Edges Rhea County 4-3

Kade Hyde was lights out on the mound Tuesday night, striking out 10 batters over six innings to lead the McMinn County Cherokees to a 4-3 win over Rhea County in a hard-fought District 5-4A matchup at home.

Hyde allowed just three hits and three runs while walking three in his six-inning start. Luke Lawson closed the game with a scoreless seventh, earning the save.

McMinn trailed early after Rhea took a 2-0 lead in the second, but the Cherokees responded in the bottom of the frame. Lawson doubled in a run, and Chase McDonald followed with a two -RBI single to put McMinn ahead 3-2. Rhea tied it in the third on an error, but Auston Fugate's sacrifice bunt in the sixth proved to be the game-winner.

McDonald and Lawson each drove in a run, while McDonald also stole two bases. The Cherokees collected eight hits overall.

Rhea's Jax Schmitt led the visitors with an RBI double and a hit, while Levi Love allowed three runs on eight hits over five innings. With the win, McMinn improves to 12-7, while Rhea falls to 5-11.
