Brush Chipper Overturns Into Creek; Driver Transported, Hazmat Team Responds



On Monday, April 14 at approximately 5:00 p.m., on Highway 163 in Delano, a 2002 International 4700 chipper truck towing a 2016 Vermeer BC1500 brush chipper left the roadway and crashed, resulting in the brush chipper overturning into a creek. The driver was transported by AMR to Bradley Medical Center in Cleveland for evaluation. The accident led to a hydraulic oil spill, which was contained and cleaned up by the McMinn County Hazmat Team.

Emergency crews from Claxton Fire Department and Etowah Rural Fire Department responded to the scene, along with Tennessee Highway Patrol Trooper Caleb Ballard, who conducted the investigation. Lt. Jonathan Bartley of the Claxton Fire De-



partment served as scene commander.

The cause of the crash is under investigation.



Tennessee Unemployment Rate Sees First Decline Since May 2024



Tennessee's unemployment rate dropped slightly in March, marking the first monthly decline since May 2024, according to the latest figures from the Tennessee Department of Labor and

Workforce Development (TDLWD).

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for March stood at 3.6%, a 0.1% decrease from February. Prior to the dip, the rate had held steady at 3.7% for six consecutive months. A year earlier, in March 2024, the rate was 3.1%.

Tennessee's unemployment rate remains well below the national average, which was 4.2% in March. The U.S. rate was 4.1% in February and 3.9% in March of the previous year.

Over the past year, the state added 8,700 nonfarm jobs, with the Government sector leading the way, followed by Leisure and Hospitality and Trade, Transportation, and Utilities. However, between February and March, nonfarm employment declined by 1,300 jobs, with the Financial Activities sector seeing the most losses. The Education and Health Services and Manufacturing sectors also posted modest job reductions. *Source: TN.gov*
