Fire at McMinn Jail Quickly Contained, No Injuries Reported



A fire broke out in the laundry area of the McMinn County Jail on the evening of May 19 but was quickly brought under control by jail staff and the Athens City Fire Department.

The fire began around 8:30 p.m. when an inmate doing laundry noticed a flash in one of the dryers. Flames spread beneath the

unit, prompting a rapid response from staff, inmate trustees, and patrol deputies.

"Fire extinguishers were deployed and inmates in nearby housing units were evacuated to safe areas due to smoke," said Sheriff Joe Guy. "Athens City Fire Department responded within minutes and attacked the fire from the dryer as well as the roof vent and had it contained with minimal damage."

No injuries were reported, and all inmates were safely returned to their housing units by 9:30 p.m.

"We will patch the roof and the laundry will be down for a day or so, but we are still operational," added Sheriff Guy.

this Friday, May 23.



Tennessee's New NIL Law Sparks Controversy Across College Sports

Tennessee recently passed <u>Senate Bill 536</u>, a new law allowing student-athletes to receive payments from NIL collectives—even amid uncertainty surrounding the NCAA House Settlement. The law is seen as a way to shield universities like Tennessee and Vanderbilt from potential lawsuits, stating athletes can earn NIL money unless prohibited by "federal law, antitrust law, or a valid court order."

Critics argue the law gives schools like Tennessee too much power to pay athletes on their own terms. Some have even called for the NCAA or SEC Commissioner Greg Sankey to take action, with extreme suggestions like removing Tennessee and Vanderbilt from the SEC.

Tennessee AD Danny White defended the move, saying, "It gives us (Tennessee) protection from the legal and structural uncertainties of college sports."

Meanwhile, power conferences are reportedly drafting a new contract that would require schools to follow future enforcement rules. Schools that refuse to sign could face removal from their conference—putting Tennessee and Vanderbilt in a tough spot if the law clashes with conference guidelines.

As the situation evolves, Tennes- Morning Fax's see's aggressive stance has clearly made waves in the college athletics world—and it's far from over.
