
A cardiac patient was airlifted by Life Force to Erlanger Hospital in



Driver Escapes Serious Injury After Early Morning Crash on Hwy 39E



A single-vehicle accident occurred around 5:30 a.m. Monday on Highway 39 East near County Road 463 after the driver of a 2007 Honda FIT reportedly fell asleep at the wheel.

The vehicle left the roadway, striking an embankment and ditch. The driver sustained minor injuries but declined medical treatment at the scene.

Responding agencies included the McMinn County Sheriff's Department, Englewood Rural Fire Department, and the Tennessee Highway Patrol. The crash was investigated by THP Trooper Travis Ryans.

Tennessee to Host NCAA Baseball Regional



For the fourth time in five years, the Tennessee Volunteers will host an NCAA Baseball Regional at Lindsey Nelson Stadium as they begin their 2025 postseason run and defend their national title.

The Knoxville Regional features No. 2 seed Wake Forest (ACC), No. 3 seed Cincinnati (Big 12), and No. 4 seed Miami (OH), the Mid-American Conference champion. Tennessee, the No. 14 national seed, opens play on Friday, May 30 at 6 p.m. ET against Miami (OH), following the 1 p.m. matchup between Wake Forest and Cincinnati. Both games will Morning Fax stream live on ESPN+.

UT is making its sixth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance and 15th overall. At home, the Vols have been dominant, posting a 23-5 all-time record in NCAA regional games at Lindsey Nelson Stadium, including a perfect 9-0 under Vitello.

A limited number of single-session standing-room-only tickets will be available to the public at the stadium beginning 90 minutes before each game. The first 500 University of Tennessee students will be admitted free to all postseason games. Season ticket holders had first access to postseason ticket purchases.
