# Etowah FD Receives Donation to Help Save Pets

The Etowah Fire Department has received four new pet oxygen kits thanks to a generous donation from The Mona Pants Foundation.

The specialized kits, which allow firefighters to administer oxygen to animals suffering from smoke inhalation or other breathing issues, will be used by the department's K-9 program and during emergency calls involving pets. Each kit has been placed on the department's main fire trucks and K-9 units to ensure quick access when needed.

Officials said the donation came at no cost to taxpayers and will help first responders provide better care to both working dogs and family pets affected by fires or other emergencies.






