

TWU Launches Fully Online Degree Completion Program for Adult Learners

Tennessee Wesleyan University is expanding educational opportunities for adult learners through its fully online Degree Completion Program in Leadership Development. The program is designed for individuals who previously started but did not complete a bachelor's degree, offering a flexible option for working adults to return to school and advance their careers on their own schedule.

Tuition is set at \$1,160 per course, and all classes are delivered asynchronously, allowing students to balance coursework with full-time jobs, family responsibilities, and other commitments. University officials emphasize that completing a degree later in life is both possible and achievable with the right support.

Students may tailor their studies by selecting one of six concentrations: Accounting, Communication Studies, Management, Health-care Management, Human Resources Management, or Industrial Management. Each pathway is structured to build practical skills and leadership abilities relevant across a variety of industries.

Sweetwater Bank-Fraud Investigation Leads to Multiple Arrests, Recovery of \$15,000



Detectives with the Sweetwater Police Department, working jointly with the Vonore Police Department, launched an investigation on Monday, Nov. 10, into a bank-fraud case involving incidents reported between Nov. 6 and 8. Officers quickly identified a suspect and vehicle tied to the crimes and distributed the information to surrounding law-enforcement agencies.

The Blount County Sheriff's Office later located the vehicle with three occupants. After one suspect attempted to flee on foot, all three individuals were taken into custody.

The primary suspect, Eddie Montgomery, was served with felony warrants and was also discovered to be wanted in Atlanta in connection with a bank robbery earlier this month. He was taken into custody by the U.S. Marshals Service and transferred back to Georgia.

The individual who ran from deputies, Marvin Jenkins, was linked to additional felony offenses in Sweetwater. Authorities say more charges and warrants have been issued for him.

During the investigation, officers recovered more than \$15,000 in cash, along with fraudulent checks and fake identifications believed to have been used in multiple identity-theft and fraud cases. Sweetwater Police officials expressed appreciation for the assistance of the Blount County Sheriff's Office, Vonore Police Department, and the U.S. Marshals Service.

All suspects are presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law.


