



Tennessee Gas Prices Dip as East Tennessee Drivers See Savings at the Pump



Drivers in McMinn County and across East Tennessee are continuing to see relief at the pump as gas prices remain well below this time last year, despite minor weekly fluctuations.

According to AAA - The Auto Club Group, Tennessee's average gas price fell three cents over the past week to \$2.52 per gallon. That is one cent more than a month ago but 27 cents cheaper than a year ago. Nationally, the average price stood at \$2.92 as of Feb. 16, still well below the \$3.15 average recorded one year ago.

Locally, McMinn County motorists were paying an average of \$2.46 per gallon. Surrounding counties reported Meigs County at \$2.63, Monroe County at \$2.52, Roane County at \$2.47, Polk County at \$2.55 and Bradley County at \$2.47. Chattanooga and Knoxville were among the least expensive metro markets in the state at \$2.45 and \$2.46, respectively, while Jackson, Nashville and Memphis posted the highest averages.

New data from the U.S. Energy Information Administration shows gasoline demand and supply both increased last week, while crude oil inventories rose by 8.5 million barrels. Even with expected seasonal fluctuations heading into spring, drivers in McMinn County and the surrounding region are paying significantly less than they were a year ago.

Wind-Driven Brush Fire Burns Four Acres on Highway 30 East



A brush fire scorched approximately four acres Saturday evening along Highway 30 East in Athens after embers from a previously burned brush pile were reignited by gusty winds.

The fire broke out around 6:30 p.m. Authorities said the property owner had burned a brush pile several days earlier, but increasing winds caused lingering embers to spread into nearby woods.

Responding agencies included Englewood Rural Fire, Etowah Rural Fire, Etowah City Fire and Athens Rural Fire. Etowah Rural Deputy Chief Dustin Ruebush served as incident commander at the scene. No injuries were reported.
